# Liverpool World Museum, Liverpool City Council

Project cost: £40,000

AP Mitchell was appointed by CBRE on behalf of Liverpool City Council to undertake mechanical building services in one of the most iconic buildings within the City of Liverpool. Within this historic site our team delivered a full boiler plant rebuild in two separate boiler rooms and the full redesign and build of the hot water systems within the museum, involving the replacement of existing calorifiers with plate heat exchangers and buffer vessels. Again, this work was conducted while keeping the site fully operational.



Northgate Arena, Equans

Project cost: £1.2 million

AP Mitchell was appointed by Equans on behalf of Cheshire West and Chester Council to undertake major mechanical engineering works as part of the leisure centre refurbishment works.

Importantly, our work had to be completed without necessitating the closure of the centre. AP Mitchell was responsible for replacing the existing boiler plant, hot water plant, Air Handling Units serving the pools and gym, a full changing room ventilation system, and a new trend BMS system throughout. We also provided the installation of an Air Source Heat Pump system to heat the main pool and a full domestic water booster set and tanks.

## Sankey House, Your Housing Group Project cost: £12,500

Your Housing Group invested in a new main hub for their business which is located on the Birchwood park estate in Warrington.

As part of a wider M&E package AP Mitchell were employed to install several EV Charging points which would allow employees to charge their cars whilst working and visiting the site.

6 New Motion charging stations, part of the Shell Recharge Network, were installed within the main car park accompanied by a new electrical feeder pillar capable of supplying a further 6 chargers in the future as the demand for EV grows.

One of the largest boiler replacement works we have undertaken to date; AP Mitchell Group was appointed by The Jockey Club to replace the boilers within the Millennium Grandstand at Newmarket Racecourse. This project took place between the end of 2020 and the start of 2021, and involved the removal of the existing boilers, water heaters, flues, and pipework with new installations. While this work was being undertaken a temporary boiler plant was setup by our team, so the function of the Grandstand was unimpeded during our work.



# Millennium Point, D Stanley Associates Project cost: £500,000

AP Mitchell was appointed through D Stanley Associates on behalf of Millennium Point to undertake a major upgrade project to the security systems around the huge Birmingham site. Our work took place over 26 weeks and involved designing and installing a new bespoke security room fitted with new displays and hardware. This control room enables the operators to make full use of the new graphical user interface, combining a massive amount of data from what were previously disparate systems into one location. Our works also involved upgrades to over 130 cameras and radio systems around the site, both internally and externally. The camera systems contain a range of features from night vision to improved real time image capture.



Project cost: £43,000




# Worcester Police Station, West Mercia Police

Project cost: £220,000

AP Mitchell Group secured and delivered this project in 2021, which involved a combination of mechanical and electrical works at Worcester Police Station. Our works here involved the safe isolation of the site, relocating 2 electrical car charging points and preparing the site for new installations. Once the old pipework, chillers and louvres were stripped out, we installed 2 new Daikin air chillers, cleaned and reinstalled the louvres, installed new silencers and then fitted new pipework and circulation pumps. Further to this, we provided electrical services to the new chillers and made modifications to the BMS to accommodate the new equipment.

### NEO Bankside Pavilion E, Native Land

Project cost:£254,000

AP Mitchell Group conducted mechanical and electrical engineering works within the new property development at NEO Banskide Pavilion E in London. Our work at this site included the isolating and removal of an existing chiller unit, which was replaced with new air handling units and coils. The existing unit was integrated within the building's lighting and fire alarm system, so we also provided an upgrade to the lighting systems on the first and second floors of the building. This included installing new Thorlux open area illuminators, as well as new emergency lighting. AP Mitchell Group were also responsible for making modifications to the fire alarm system.
