Previously, Places for People provided £1000 vouchers for tenants to purchase their own flooring at retailers like Carpetright. However, those funds were only sufficient enough to carpet more than a room or two. Through Furlong's generous support, residents will now receive flooring for their entire home.

The initial rollout will focus on Places for People's Lancashire properties, with a local third-party fitter installing Furlong's popular Avondale carpet range throughout living spaces, bedrooms and other high-traffic areas. Resilient luxury vinyl tile (LVT) or rigid core Endura SPC flooring may also be specified for kitchens and bathrooms.

"A house is not a house until it becomes a home," said Hulme. "Furlong's diverse, high-performance product catalogue will enable us to create that warm homely environment while being fantastic partners committed to our mission."

As the relationship progresses, Places for People aims to standardise on the Furlong flooring solutions across all void properties being renovated and turned over to new residents. The housing provider manages over 200,000 homes spanning retirement villages, student accommodation, specialist assisted living and traditional social housing tenures. Hulme emphasised the Furlong partnership aligns perfectly with Places for People's core values of corporate social responsibility and community empowerment.

"We are a business, but one driven by the purpose of affecting positive change," he stated. "Having Furlong's support will truly make a difference with people most in need of our services. We're eager to see this partnership expand nationwide."
