

MEDITE SMARTPLY German Emissions Testing Statement

On 01.01.2020, the German authorities changed the formaldehyde (HCHO) emission test method for wood-based panels. The new test method is a modified version of EN16516 with a limit value of 0.1ppm. The EN717-1 test method as stated in the EN13986 can still be used, however the result must be multiplied by a factor of 2 and still be less than 0.1ppm.
